HOW TO USE THIS PAGE

Read this first.

Print what you need

Every page is US Letter (8.5 x 11 inches) and designed to print in black and white. Print single pages as you need them, or print the whole planner and put it in a three-ring binder.

Start with one page

You do not need to use every worksheet. Pick the one page that matches what is hardest right now, use it for a month, then add another.

Write in pencil

Budgets change. Pencil makes it easier to adjust without starting a page over.

Review on a schedule

Put a recurring 20-minute money review on your calendar. The review pages in this planner are built for that time slot.

Pair it with the free tools

The free calculators at ballerbudgeting.com can do the math; these pages are where you keep the results and track what actually happens.
